The house is peacefully located between forest, beach, and lighthouse, close to the harbour and town. Walk to Nakkehoved Lighthouse, follow the Fyrstien coastal path towards Gilleleje, find a quiet spot on the beach, or end the day on the terrace at sunset.

The house is yours during your stay

Everything in the house and garden is available for your use. Relax and make yourselves at home, while treating Fyrhøj with the same care you would show your own home.

Laundry

A washing machine, tumble dryer, and drying rack are available for your use.

Internet & TV

The house has internet and a Smart TV. Please sign out of your personal streaming services before departure.

Take your time

Fyrhøj is made for slow mornings, coastal walks, and quiet evenings. There is no need to rush.

During your stay

- **Wood-burning stove**

Please use ordinary firewood or wood briquettes, available from Brugsen and Jem & Fix. The firewood stored in the shed is private and must not be used.

- **Smoking**

Smoking is permitted outdoors only, so the house remains pleasant for future guests.

- **Waste**

Place waste in the containers by the road and sort it according to the labels on the containers.

- **Problems or faults**

Please let us know as soon as possible if something is not working. The sooner we hear from you, the sooner we can resolve it.

- **Damage**

If anything is broken or damaged, we expect the responsible guest to cover the cost of repair or replacement.

- **Electricity**

Recorded electricity consumption is settled after the stay through the Airbnb Resolution Centre.

Please contact us whenever needed

We would like the opportunity to help while you are still at the house. Please message us immediately if you have questions or encounter a problem.

Before you leave

- Please tidy up after yourselves and your guests, both indoors and in the garden.
- Empty the refrigerator, dishwasher, and coffee machine.
- Place used towels and bed linen in the utility room.
- Close all windows, lock the doors, and return the keys as agreed.
- Check that you have taken all personal belongings with you.

Discover Gilleleje

Gilleleje is a lively coastal town with a working fishing harbour, small shops, cafés, restaurants, and some of North Zealand's finest walks by the sea.

Nakkehoved Lighthouse

Enjoy the view across the Kattegat and visit the lighthouse history museum.

Gilleleje Harbour

Fishing boats, restaurants, ice cream, and a maritime atmosphere all year round.

Gilbjerg Hoved

Zealand's northernmost point, with sweeping views across the sea.

Fyrstien

A scenic coastal path between Nakkehoved Lighthouse and Gilleleje Harbour.

Beaches & coastal walks



Strandbakkerne

The nearest beach, with a dramatic coastal landscape, panoramic views, and good swimming.

West Beach

A wide sandy beach close to town, with a bathing jetty and good conditions for families.

Fyrstien

Follow the coast between Nakkehoved Lighthouse and Gilleleje Harbour - beautiful in every season.

Our tip: Go early in the morning or late in the day. The light over the Kattegat is often at its best when the beach is quiet.

Activities in and around Gilleleje

1 Walking

Explore Fyrstien, Gilbjergstien, and the coastal landscape around Nakkehoved.

2 Cycling

Follow quiet roads and coastal routes towards Smidstrup, Dronningmølle, and Hornbæk.

3 Kayaking & paddleboarding

See the coast from the water on calm days. Check local hire providers and weather conditions.

4 Sea fishing

Fish from the pier or coast, or book a trip from the harbour.

5 Golf

Gilleleje Golf Club is a short drive from the house.

6 Tennis & padel

Courts are available in Gilleleje and nearby towns.

7 Mini golf

Enjoy a family-friendly round of mini golf in Dronningmølle.

8 Mountain biking

Marked trails in Gribskov offer routes for beginners and experienced riders.

BEST VIEW

Fyrkroen

Dinner with panoramic Kattegat views, only about a five-minute walk from Fyrhøj.

BEST FISH

Adamsens Fisk

Fresh fish, classic seafood dishes, and an informal harbour atmosphere.

BEST PIZZA

Costa Smeralda

Crisp Italian pizzas in a relaxed atmosphere.

BEST EVENING ATMOSPHERE

Bistro No. 3

Modern bistro food, good wines, and a relaxed evening in the town centre.

BEST ICE CREAM STOP

ISEN serving Hansens Is

Take a traditional Danish ice cream to the pier and enjoy the harbour and Kattegat.

Opening hours vary by season - always check the venue's own website.

Places to eat in Gilleleje

Fyrkroen

Lunch or dinner with sweeping Kattegat views, especially atmospheric on a summer evening.

Betty

Restaurant, street food, and a summery atmosphere close to the water.

Bistro No. 3

A concise seasonal menu, quality ingredients, and a relaxed bistro atmosphere.

Restaurant Gilleleje Havn

Locally caught fish, classic dishes, and harbour views.

Adamsens Fisk

Fish shop, deli, and casual seafood dishes by the harbour.

Costa Smeralda

Pizza, pasta, and salads - a casual choice for families or takeaway.

Spisehuset Bolværket

Seasonal cooking, classic dishes, and pizza from a wood-fired stone oven at Kulturhavnen.

Reservations

In high season, book well in advance, especially for Friday and Saturday evenings.

Cafés, ice cream & shopping

A break in town

Gilleleje town centre and harbour have several cafés and coffee spots. Pause between the shops, find a seat overlooking the fishing boats, or enjoy an ice cream on the pier.

Coffee & cafés

Café Vaabengaard and the cafés around the harbour and Kulturhavnen are good choices for coffee, lunch, or a glass of wine.

Ice cream by the harbour

ISEN serves Hansens Is, freshly baked cones, and homemade marshmallow topping. Søsters is another local option at the harbour.

Combine Hamlet's castle with the award-winning maritime museum in Helsingør.

- **Louisiana Museum of Modern Art**
Art, architecture, and views across the Øresund in Humlebæk.
- **Esrum Abbey**
History, nature, and tranquillity in the Royal North Zealand National Park.
- **Rudolph Tegnors Museum & Statuepark**
Art and landscape in distinctive surroundings near Dronningmølle.

Three great days in Gilleleje

Use these suggestions as inspiration, or simply choose what suits the weather and your mood.

THE RELAXED DAY

- MORNING** Coffee on the terrace and a walk to Strandbakkerne.
- AFTERNOON** Walk Fyrstien to the harbour, then lunch and shops in town.
- EVENING** Dinner at Fyrkroen and sunset over the Kattegat.

THE ACTIVE DAY

- MORNING** Cycle along the coast towards Dronningmølle.
- AFTERNOON** Kayaking, paddleboarding, or golf.
- EVENING** Pizza from Costa Smeralda and a quiet evening in the garden.

THE CULTURE DAY

- MORNING** Drive to Helsingør and visit Kronborg.
- AFTERNOON** Visit M/S Maritime Museum or Louisiana.
- EVENING** Bistro No. 3 or a casual dinner by the harbour.
